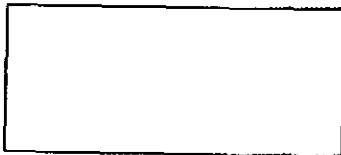

1. Per your request, officers [Redacted] met with [Redacted] [Redacted] could not answer any of the critical questions in your request, however, he was assigned in Korea for nine months between [Redacted] and he meets some of the criterion according to your memorandum. He stated that in accordance with the Armistice Agreement, two commissions were created. He was a member of one of these commissions, the [Redacted]. He was not a member of the other commission, the [Redacted]. The country chairman of the latter commission was [Redacted] and that country contributed [Redacted] troops to the monitoring forces. [Redacted] used to prepare reports for the five teams both for North and South Korea. In addition to being a member of the commission, [Redacted] stated, that in his personal opinion, the Chinese government might have information about missing Americans from the Korean conflict. He also mentioned that the Czechoslovak government had a medical doctor assigned in Korea [Redacted] was also a member of the Central Committee of the Communist Party [Redacted] from November 1954 to August 1956.
