Plaintiff Roger Hall moves for an extension of time, to and including October 10, 2016, to respond to defendant's renewed motion for summary judgment.

1. By this Court's order issued August 15, 2016, ECF # 249, plaintiff's response to defendant's motion for summary judgment is due September 28, 2016.

2. Since that date counsel has filed two major briefs in Clemente v. F.B.I., C.A. No. 08-1252, and a third major brief in Clemente v. F.B.I., C.A. No. 13-0108. On September 12, 2016, he filed a major brief in Clemente v. F.B.I., D.C. Cir. No. 16-5067. 
